As August was mostly a month off for the American Space; hence the small number of events and participants.

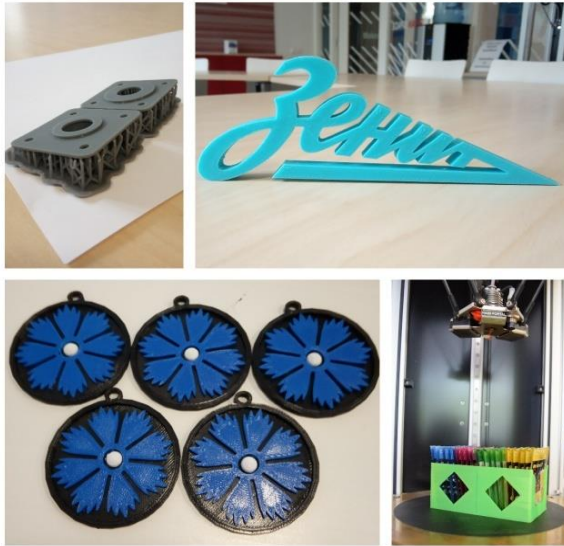
New and most popular programs:



“Summer with a Book”

The Summer Reading Program “Summer with a Book” was completed on September 1. It ran from June 3 to August 30 in the library’s Children Department.

230 kids participated in the program supported by the U.S. Embassy through the American Space funding. Students read books by American authors and answered questions based on the stories they read. During the entire period, students had to answer 2,180 questions and got to eat 1,090 ice creams as a reward. Some of the participants read more than 15-17 books and the youngest reader was a 5-year-old boy. Importantly, students with special needs participated in this project.
